Durango Juvenile Courts & Detention Facility

Phoenix, Arizona



Durango Juvenile Courts and Detention Facility, located in Phoenix, Arizona, consists of a one-story, 134,000 square foot facility containing 220 beds, administrative and educational areas. An additional 3-story 120,000 square foot courts building contains 12 courtrooms, judicial chambers, and associated legal support areas.

Norment furnished and installed security hollow metal doors and frames, Airteq System's security hardware including 267 swing locks, and 8 sliding devices, security glass and glazing, and security ceilings.

This project was an upgrade of the security system for an existing juvenile detention facility that included the addition of a 3 wing housing unit. Security electronics included door locking control and monitoring, PA/intercom, CCTV, MATV, and personal alarm systems, integrated with PLC's and touchscreen control stations.
