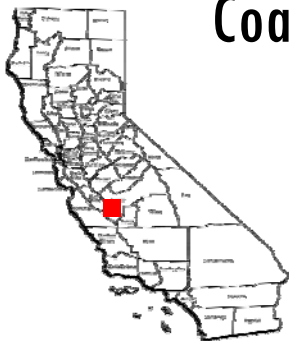

Located in Central California, Coalinga Secure Treatment Facility is a 1500 bed, maximum security, licensed psychiatric hospital complex with numerous support facilities.

Its 1.1 million gross square footage includes 1100 detention openings, operated primarily by mechanical detention hardware, and 28 patient housing/treatment units with appurtenant services, support, and administrative units.

Norment furnished and installed all detention hollow metal, and detention hardware from Airteq Systems that included both electro-mechanical and mechanical locks.

Norment's Trentech Division provided an integrated security electronics system which included locking control systems, intercom, paging, and nurse call systems, Programmable Logic Control, electronic controls and control panels, CCTV, CATV, touchscreens, personal duress and Uninterruptable Power System, and coaxial and microwave perimeter detection system.
