The Ortiz Correctional Facilities is a campus style facility with minimum, medium and maximum holding areas, located just outside Fort Meyers, FL. The Main jail is located downtown. This was a design/build project.

Norment Security Group performed this contract as the DEC/ESS. Our Scope of work included furnishing and installing the detention hollow metal, Airteq pneumatic locks and sliding devices and mechanical locks, detention furnishings, security glass & glazing. Trentech, (Div. of Norment) provided the engineering, programming and integration for the security control system which included: Paging and Intercom Systems, PLC (OMRON, CV Series) Systems with take over capabilities from one area of the campus to another, CCTV Matrix System utilizing fiber connectivity, Access Control Systems, Duress Systems, Perimeter Detection System, and Touchscreen Control consoles. Communications between logic controllers was accomplished via Ethernet Lan Network, utilizing non-proprietary protocols.

Norment also provided integrated security electronics for the downtown facility which was renovated and expanded. The downtown structure is a high rise facility with administrative areas on the ground floor and inmate housing on the above floors.
