Turner-Guilford-Knight Correctional Center

Miami, Florida



The Turner-Guilford-Knight (TGK) Correctional Center located in Miami-Dade County, Florida is a multi-story building consisting of approximately 1300 beds. These beds house both male and female inmates of various levels of custody. Officers work inside housing units 24 hours a day supervising directly.

The project was a fast track completion schedule. The construction schedule began in August of 1994 and was completed in March of 1995 approximately 7 months after the contract award. Norment's scope of work consisted primarily of security electronics. Some of the sub systems included providing (8) touchscreens, locking controls, graphic panels, intercom/paging, CCTV and duress systems for the 9 story building.
