U.S. Penitentiary - Coleman I

Wildwood, Florida



This design/build U.S. Penitentiary is a maximum security prison that houses approximately 1,000 inmates on a campus of varying security level facilities. It sits on more than 100 acres. Each 18 meter guard tower is surrounded by double rows of high security fencing.

The design includes precast concrete cells and exterior wall panels. A security corridor connects all seven (7) housing units to food, medical/dental, psychological, religious services, as well as vocational, training, visitation and administration services.

Norment scopes of work included the furnishing and installation of detention and commercial hollow metal, **Airteq** detention locks and sliding devices, security and non-security glass/glazing, security woven wire mesh and grating, detention furnishings and accessories.
