# U.S. Penitentiary - Coleman II

Wildwood, Florida



The U.S. Penitentiary II is a high security facility housing male inmates. It is included as part of the Coleman Federal Correctional Complex. The prison is located in central Florida, approximately fifty miles northwest of Orlando. This was a design/build project.

As a high security prison it must meet the requirements of having highly secured perimeters, multiple and single occupant cell housing, the highest staff to inmate ratio, and close control of inmate movement.

Norment furnished and installed security hollow metal, standard hollow metal, **Airteq** detention locks and sliding devices, security/non-security glass and glazing, security mesh and grating, security furniture, and security accessories.
